Studio in the Woods 2009

WHAT

Studio in the Woods is an ongoing educational programme with the intention of encouraging the development of an architectural agenda through the direct experience of the construction of experimental architectural installations designed to reveal an aspect of place.

The program is aimed at architectural students, and practicing architects.

Studio in the Woods 2009 will take place in 1000 acres of privately managed habitat in Gloucestershire, from the afternoon of Thursday 9th July 2009 to the afternoon of Sunday 12th July 2009.

Units will be run by a number of award winning architects, including Erect Architecture, Mole Architects, Gianni Botsford Architects, Feilden Clegg Bradley, Mitchell Taylor Workshop and Kate Darby Architects, with a number of visiting distinguished critics including Peter Clegg and Ted Cullinan, and technical support from Charley Brentnall.

The main brief will be presented to the students at 5.00pm on Thursday 3rd July. This will be followed by Unit Presentations, and you will then have the chance to sign up for a particular unit, which will be:

- Unit 1 - Gianni Botsford Architects with Kate Darby
- Unit 2 - Toby Lewis (Partner, Feilden Clegg Bradley)
- Unit 3 - Mole Architects with Mitchell Taylor Workshop
- Unit 4 - Erect Architecture

The cost of the event is £220

WHERE

Studio in the Woods 2009 is being held at Kemerton Court Farm, Kemerton, Glos, GL20 7HY. The main centre for the event (food, camping, talks etc) will be Kemerton Court Farm and you should arrive here. A detailed map will be sent to you prior to the event. Also, look at www.kemerton.org in advance of the studio to give you background information.

WHEN

Studio in the Woods begins at 5.00pm on Thursday 9th July, and finishes after lunch on the 12th July. It is **ESSENTIAL** that you have arrived and set up your tent by 4.30 at the latest. We recommend you arrive on site by 3.00, which means you should allow to catch a train that arrives by 2.30 at the latest.

GETTING THERE

By Car:

M5 Junction 9, East on A46 approx 2 miles, Left on B4079, Right after approx 2 miles to Kemerton.

By Train:

to Evesham (From London), Ashchurch (Closest) or Cheltenham (from the North) then taxi to Kemerton.

Please let us know your travel plans as soon as possible. If there are enough people arriving by train at the same time, we will arrange for group taxis. Similarly, if you have space in your car, please let us know.

ACCOMMODATION

You will be camping, and will need to bring your own camping equipment - i.e. tent, sleeping bag, etc

FOOD

We are providing all meals, but bring snacks etc - you'll get hungry. It's also a good idea to bring your own water bottles... and Alcohol.

BRING

Sketchbooks, Cameras, Penknives, Your favourite tool (if you have one), WET WEATHER GEAR - Assume it will be pouring! But also bring suncream just in case...
